Hispanic Leadership Alliance Scholarship Program

The Hispanic Leadership Alliance FCPS, Inc. (HLA) is a non-profit organization of Fairfax County Public School employees and residents established in 1997, whose mission is to promote an understanding of Hispanic culture, empower parents with educational information, provide leadership training and opportunities to its members and encourage student participation in advanced academic programs, leadership activities, and school completion.

The Hispanic Leadership Alliance has established a scholarship program for first generation Hispanic students<sup>\*</sup> of Fairfax County Public Schools in pursuit of a post high school education. HLA will be awarding six \$1,000.00 scholarships this year.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for the scholarships offered by the **Hispanic Leadership Alliance**, a first generation\* Hispanic high school senior of Fairfax County Public Schools must identify his or her career choices, and also the name of the accredited college, technical school, or university he or she plans to attend. The scholarship must be disbursed no later than September 1, 2015.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Applicants are evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 1. Academic achievement (grades and SAT/ACT scores)
- 2. Student application (including student essay)
- 3. Two Recommendations (an academic recommendation from a current teacher and a personal recommendation from guidance counselor or community leader).

### **Application Process**

- 1. Student must complete the application form.
- 2. Student must give and collect the two recommendation forms by the deadline and provide the forms to his/her school's guidance counselor.
- 3. Student is responsible for submitting all the parts of the completed application to his or her guidance counselor **by Monday**, **March 17**, **2014**.

#### **Selection Process**

The Hispanic Leadership Alliance will request high school principals and faculty members to identify potential applicants.

### **Award Presentation**

The Hispanic Leadership Alliance will host an event in the late spring where scholarship sponsors will meet those students who have been selected.

<sup>\*</sup>A first generation Hispanic student is one born abroad or to immigrant parents in the United States. The student must be the first one in his/her family to attempt a post high school education.
